- First Aid - Open to ALL fully enrolled cadets, age 12-18. Cadets permitted to wear Class 3 badge on successful completion. Students will require T7, notebook, pencil, scruff rig for practical sessions.
- Exped. - Open to any cadet or adult already holding Basic ET. Successful cadets will be allowed to wear Proficiency ET badge. Students will require kit for 24 hr expedition, and will be assessed on the kit they elect to bring. Adult candidates are welcome.
- Seamanship - Open to ALL cadets aged 12-18. On successful completion, Class 3 badge may be worn. Students will require T7, taskbook, notepad, pencil.
- Cook/Steward - Open to ALL cadets aged 12-18. Class 3 badge may be worn on successful completion. Students will require T7, taskbook (10p from instructor), pencil, notebook, small mixing bowl, 2 eggs, apron and scruff rig for cooking, HALF BLUES WITH SHOES for steward inspection.
- Writer/Stores - Open to ALL cadets aged 12-18. Class 3 badge may be worn on successful completion. Students will require T7, taskbook, pen and notebook, materials to construct training aids, and a pre-prepared 5 min lesson on any SCC subject.
- Instructional Methods - Open to senior cadets AC and above. IM grading will be given on completion. Students will need pen, notebook, and materials to prepare training aids.
