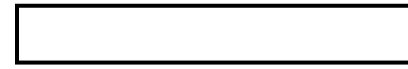

- (Bugle Training will be using the Chris Boulton's "Fun to Bugle" books, if you have them please bring them)
- COST:** There is no cost for this training day, however the NAAFI will be open so a small amount of spending money can be brought.
- EQUIPMENT:** If you have any drum sticks or bugles that you'd prefer to use then bring it along with you, please note this on your entry forms. If you do not then equipment will be provided.
- RIG:** Staff & Cadets: Civvies
- ENTRIES:** On District Entry Forms to DSO(BAND) PO MENDRYS at Enfield Unit no later than 3rd February 2007.
- NOTE:** Please note that this is a 'taster' day, it is aimed at encouraging cadets who may not have access to band training. It is designed to give them a taster of music within the SCC – it does not qualify cadets for their drumming or bugling badge, this can only be done by the ASO(Band). It is understood that there is no current ASO(BAND), but there will be provision for the latter part of the year for those ready to take assessment. **Cadets staying for both drum AND bugle workshops will require a pack-lunch.** Certificates will be given to all candidates showing that they attended the day.
