First Aid - Run by ASO(FA), this is the one day "appointed persons" course, and is the minimum requirement for adults in the Corps

Seamanship - Will allow successful adults to teach the class 3 syllabus within their own units. This is a full 2 day course.

I.M - Open to all adults, resulting in an IM grade which is a requirement for any adult teaching cadets. Full 2 day course.

D of E Co-ordinators - A one day course to enable any designated adult to easily run and administer the D of E scheme in their own unit.

RNP Preparation - A one day course for ALL those involved in preparing the unit for both URV and RNP. Includes the new format for Training and Admin visits, evolutions, paperwork, etc.

Weapons Control - One day course covering all aspects of Weapons control paperwork and safety including regulations for movement of weapons and ammunition, expenditure at firing point, etc.

Child awareness - a 2-hour presentation commencing at around 1400 by Area BMD Mrs Jane Perkins. All those already booked on above courses will attend, plus any others who may wish to book a place. There will be no charge for those attending this presentation only.
