## D of E BRONZE EXPEDITION (WATERBORNE)

We will be holding a Duke of Edinburgh's Award Bronze Expedition over the weekend of 13<sup>th</sup> - 15<sup>th</sup> July 2007.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS DATE IS A CHANGE FROM THAT PUBLISHED IN THE DISTRICT DIARY.**

It is expected that the expedition will take place on the River Lea, but only if a minimum of 5 entries is reached.

The expedition will be open to any Cadet working towards their Bronze Award who has not yet completed the expedition section. To be eligible, Cadets must have completed all necessary training, including a practice of some sort, prior to arrival at the start of the Expedition. The practice section of the Bronze logbook **MUST** be signed prior to the event.

Cadets taking part in the expedition will be expected to be completely self sufficient, and must be accommodated under canvas.

Supervision will be provided from a power boat shadowing.

Cadets will be required to attend a briefing meeting on an evening to be announced.

The Expedition will be assessed by Lt Cdr (SCC) B Sickelmore RNR and Lt (SCC) C.Lewis RNR.

A maximum of 10 Cadets will be accepted on this expedition. The expedition will run with a minimum of 5 Cadets. The minimum qualification required will be Pulling Competent crew, but a minimum of ONE cadet in each boat must hold pulling coxswain

Entries should be sent to ADO on District entry forms, stating the Cadets name, age, date of birth, pulling qualification.

No entries will be accepted after 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2007.

Full joining instructions will be sent once closing date has passed.
