DISTRICT BOAT HANDLING COMPETITIONS

- DATE:** Saturday, 23rd June 2007.
- VENUE:** LA Boating Station, Royal Victoria Docks, Tidal Basin Rd, London E16 1AF
- TIME:** Crews will be asked to report at either 1300, 1400 or 1500. Units will be advised of report times after closing date.
- TEAMS:**
Power Boat - To consist of 2 cadets + 1 cox'n, all to be fully enrolled.
Pulling Boat - To consist of 4 cadets + 1 cox'n, all to be fully enrolled.
Sailing Boat - To consist of 4 cadets + 1 cox'n, all to be fully enrolled.
Teams may be any combination of Male/Female/MCD
- RIG:**
Cadets: No4, inc. BOOTS/SHOES & BERET
Staff: No4
- RIG AFLOAT:** No4 negative headgear, boating shoes/plimsolls of uniform colour white, blue or black. Personal bouyancy (TARS(I)), correctly worn and secure. Clasp knife on lanyard around waist.
- AGES:** 12.0 - under 18 years as on 3rd Sept 2007.
- COXSWAINS:**
Power - Must be in possession of RYA Power Boat Level 1, or higher, correctly signed, to be sighted on the day.
Pulling - Must be in possession of SCC Pulling Cox'n, as above.
Sailing - Must be in possession of RYA Sail Level 2, or YSS Stage 3, as above.
- ENTRIES:** On District entry forms ONLY, to reach ADO no later than 17th June 2007. DO NOT SEND RYA CERTIFICATES WITH ENTRIES. THESE WILL BE SIGHTED ON THE DAY.
NO CERTIFICATE - NO COMPETITION.
- RULES:** See National Regatta Rules, (latest edition) and District Rule book page 15.
Correctly completed T1's (and T1(M) where appropriate) should accompany ALL cadets.
- Please note that at Area level, no cadet will allowed to compete on more than one of pulling, power and sailing boat handling competitions.
- Suitably qualified volunteers for safety boat and judging duties will be required.

NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 17th JUNE 2007.
