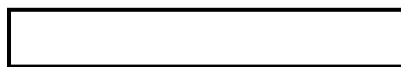


# SEA CADET CORPS

## DISTRICT EXPEDITION TRAINING COMPETITION

- DATE:** 20<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup> July 2007.
- VENUE:** TBC
- TEAMS:** To consist of team leader, navigator, plus four other cadets. Teams may consist of any combination of SCC/MCD, and may be all male, all female or mixed. The team leader must show the ability to lead a team in daylight hours in standard country, summer conditions.
- Each unit may enter ONE team only, and tentage must be arranged to avoid male/female sharing tents. The accepted combinations will be:  
3 male/3 female, 2 male/4 female, 4 male/2 female, all male or all female.  
**NO OTHER COMBINATIONS OF MALE/FEMALE WILL BE PERMITTED.**
- AGES:** At least **FOUR** team members must be 13.6 - 18.0 as on 24<sup>th</sup> Sept 2007. A maximum of two team members may be aged 12 - 13.6 on date above.
- ENTRIES:** On District entry forms **ONLY**, to reach ADO no later than 15<sup>th</sup> July 2007.
- STAFF:** Each unit is expected to nominate staff to attend and assist. Female staff are compulsory for units with female cadets in their teams. Staff with qualifications/skills or abilities to volunteer for particular duties should indicate this on the entry form.
- EQUIPMENT:** Team kit lists will **NOT** be issued to participating units this year. Teams will be marked on their ability to select appropriate kit for a Summer Class C country 48 hour expedition. Units requiring guidance should consult D of E Expedition Guide, Langmiurs Mountaircraft and Leadership, TI's or District ET qualified staff.  
Kit list for staff and work party cadets will be forwarded after closing date. Teams should travel in ET Rig, and bring No 4 rig packed seperately.
- Correctly completed T1's (and T1(M) where appropriate) should accompany **ALL** cadets, including work party/comms., and these must be presented on arrival. Failure to produce this form will result in cadets being barred from competing, and such cadets will be sent home. Units possessing equipment such as water containers, or any kit useful for command tasks, please indicate on entry forms.
- CATERING:** Both staff and cadets will be required to be completely self-sufficient with respect to providing meals and cooking facilities.  
Teams and staff will be required to provide for themselves 2 breakfast, 2 lunch and 1 evening meal. Units may use their own discretion when providing food, but please refer to ET syllabus in TI's for guidance, or references above. DSO(ET) is happy to advise. Teams carrying insufficient or unsuitable rations will not be allowed to compete.

- TRAVEL:** Please be aware that indicate on entry form preferred method of travel. Where minibuses will have spare seating, or a bus is available but requires a driver, please also indicate.
- COMMAND TASKS:** DSO(ET) will require assistance in the setting up and running of tasks. Volunteers, ideas and equipment will be required. Please contact ADO with suggestions.
- CAMPSITE**
- SUPERVISION:** 2 male and 2 female volunteers required, to be self sufficient and suitably qualified. Volunteers on Entry forms.
- D of E:** This competition will qualify as a PRACTICE for Expedition on the Award Scheme. Units must ensure that cadets logbooks are available during the competition. For assistance, units may contact ADO. Also please refer to D of E Expedition Guide, and please indicate cadets participating on entry sheet.
