DISTRICT ARMED & UNARMED DRILL COMPETITIONS

- DATE:** Sunday 9th December 2007
- VENUE:** Waltham Forest unit
- TIME:** All teams and individuals to report no later than 0930
- AGES:** Senior - Fully enrolled cadets aged 12.1 but under 18.0 on 28th April 2008. The District policy regarding ex-JSC will apply.
JSC - aged 10 but under 12 on the day of the competition.
- RIG:** Staff and Senior Cadets No 1c. Cadets may change on arrival at the venue.
JSC - JSC rig as laid down in CDR's
- NUMBERS:** These competitions are open to mixed or single sex teams, and any combination may be entered in both events.
Armed: Each unit may enter ONE team of EIGHT cadets plus ONE guard commander. Team must be all SCC or all MCD
Unarmed: Each unit may enter ONE team of EIGHT cadets plus ONE squad commander. Team must be all SCC or all MCD, and ONE team of SIX JSC's plus ONE squad commander, who may be a senior cadet.
Cadets for both events may be of any rate, but MAY NOT also compete in piping competitions.
- TEAMS MAY BE MADE UP OF CADETS FROM MORE THAN ONE UNIT. THEREFORE, JOINT ENTRIES FROM NEIGHBOURING UNITS WHO WISH TO COMBINE RESOURCES WILL BE WELCOMED. IF UNITS ARE ABLE, TEAMS MAY BE ENTERED AS 12+1, OR AS FEW AS 6+1.**
- RESERVES:** Will be allowed on the day, providing they meet age requirements.
- REFERENCE:** District Rule Book page 22. Competition will run in accordance with National requirements. Would Waltham Forest Unit please confirm that weapons and bayonets will be available on the day.
JSC DRILL WILL CONSIST OF MARCH ON, VIP INSPECTION AND 6 MIN FREE DRILL ONLY
- ENTRIES:** On District entry forms to ADO no later than 24th November 2007. Please indicate clearly cadets in armed or unarmed events.
- TROPHIES:** To be returned on the day, clean and engraved
